Getting Crafty: Wild Water Painting

You'll Need:

- Watercolor Paper
- Paint (liquid watercolor or acrylic)
- Squirt guns or squirt bottles

- Water
- Easel or clipboard

Abstract art shows what an artist thinks, feels, or is inspired by not exactly what they see!

Instructions:

- Today we're making some abstract art paintings inspired by the colors of a
 coral reef! Take a minute to look at the pictures below. What colors do you notice?
 (We might get messy so the rest of this project is best set up outside.)
- 2. Clip your watercolor paper to your easel. If you don't have an easel you can clip it to a clipboard and lean it against a tree or object. You could also tape your paper to a fence, tree, or other object you don't mind getting a little paint on.
- 3. Fill your squirt guns or squirt bottles with paint and thin it with a little water.
- 4. Stand back from your paper and SQUIRT! Watch how the colors mix, drip, and combine. What changes if you squirt close or stand far away?
