

Getting Crafty:

Mini “Gingerbread” Homes

You’ll Need:

- ◆ Mini flower pot
- ◆ Paint & brush
- ◆ Misc. decorating supplies (gems, ribbon, trees, beads, etc.)

- ◆ Cardboard Square

From Your House:

- ◆ Scissors
- ◆ Glue
- ◆ Markers

Instructions:

1. Place your cardboard square blank side up on your work surface. This is the base of your gingerbread house scene! Place your flower pot upside down onto your cardboard square. If you’d like you can glue it to the cardboard so it won’t move.
2. Decorate! Using your paint and other decorating supplies (gems, beads, ribbon, etc.) turn your flower pot into a mini “gingerbread” house. Don’t forget a door and some windows! You may also decorate the cardboard to be a little lawn....draw or paint paths, trees, bushes and more! Have fun!
3. Display your little gingerbread house somewhere where a little house or garden elf can live in it! :)
